



November 3rd, 2007 – Joyce Sensmeier MS, RN-BC, CPHIMS, FHIMSS, Co-chair, Alliance for Nursing Informatics and VP, Informatics, HIMSS presented to the Nursing Knowledge and Technology Pre-conference at the Sigma Theta Tau International Honor Society of Nursing 39<sup>th</sup> Biennial Convention on Nursing Informatics Collaboration in Baltimore, Maryland. An overview of the Alliance for Nursing Informatics was provided, focusing on the ANI history, member organizations, objectives, strategic goals and current activities. The presentation also provided an update on recent ANI accomplishments including public comments and letters of support provided to national activities such as to the U.S. Department of Labor regarding Nursing Informatics Job Occupational Codes, and a request to Google to add nursing representation to the Google Health Advisory Council. More than 200 nurses attended the Pre-conference and there was positive interest in ANI and its current work.
